FROM THE PRESIDENT

Over the past few months I have been emphasizing gratefulness. How grateful are you? Hoping this would lead to evaluating how much you give to God in the form of your offering of money each week or month. The giving of our offerings are a very important part of our worship of God and an important part of each worship service. This month though I want to emphasize the other two parts of our stewardship: time and talent. This

is the time of year when the nominating committee starts to call members asking them to give of their time and talent by serving on a board or even a member of the council. Please be ready to accept a position on one of the boards that this congregation has formed to do the work necessary to keep things running smoothly. I would go so far as to hope you would feel at least a little bit flattered that your name came up for consideration as a possible member of a board. But what would be far better is that you don't even wait for a phone call. Please call first and nominate yourself for a position that you feel you would be willing to help with. And yes this might mean 'getting out of your comfort zone'. You will see that you can indeed do it and do it well. We are a small congregation and so we need everyone to help in some way. And if you feel that all you can do is to pray, prayer is a very good way to serve. Our constitution was sent back to us with approval by the Synod. Nancy Heykes, synod secretary, has been a great help to us in this process. As a member of the synod committee to review our constitution, she continues to help us with the next steps we need to take. The committee was formed and tasked with reviewing and making necessary changes in the Constitution. The changes are small and few. It is important for us to remember the committee has been acting for the congregation as a whole instead of the whole congregation meeting to go over needed changes. So first of all, the council will need to approve the changes that have been made. Then copies of the constitution will be placed in the hands of the members of the congregation. The first of two meetings will be held, after 30 days, to go over any questions or clarifications members may have. It is very important to note that at any time a member of the council or congregation can propose an amendment or change in the new constitution if they object to it as it stands. Any changes made would mean the process would start over. If no amendments or changes are made, a first vote to accept the new constitution could be taken, as long as we have a quorum. The vote would be successful as long as 2/3 of the voting members approve. Then a 2nd meeting would be held to finalize the constitution. A quorum would be needed again and a 2/3 approval of the voting members. Stay tuned and we will let you know how this is progressing.
